
#### EASTER

Word Bank: wind, love, time, soul, air, sound


# THANK God for always speaking the truth, even when it's hard to see or understand.





When Jesus came back from the dead, it proved that what He said about eternal life is true! We can have eternal life with God if we believe that Jesus took the punishment for our sin. So Jesus offers us eternal life, but what does that really mean?

Get the biggest piece of paper you can find—it needs to be something you can tear, so ask a parent if you're unsure. Imagine that paper is eternity. Now tear off the smallest possible piece you can. Hold the tiny piece of paper up to the big piece. That tiny piece, as small as it is, is still not as small as your life on earth is compared to eternity. And Jesus promised us that if we believe everything He said is true while we're living as the small piece, we get to spend eternity—the big piece—with the One who made everything!



### READ John 14:2-4

When Jesus came back from the dead, it proved that what He said was true! So when He says that He's going to prepare a room for us in His Father's house, which is huge, He means that too. We can trust Him.
