

READ JOHN 11:41B-42

DAY 1

Lazarus was dead. He was buried. For four days. And Jesus brought him back to life! What could be bigger than that?! Even still, Jesus had to pray out loud to God so that everyone around would understand exactly who He was. It makes you wonder if God is doing big things around us all the time (He is!) and we often miss them (we do!). The miracles we see every day may not be as big as Jesus raising someone from the dead, but if we look closely, we'll see God is at work—doing stuff—everywhere, every day!

Ask your parent for a clothespin, a cotton ball or a few squares of toilet paper and glue. Pull on the cotton ball to make it longer and wrap it around the clothespin and glue it to secure the cotton. Or you could tear strips of the toilet paper and wrap them around, gluing them down. Tape or glue your little "Lazarus" to your map, near the word FAITH.

THANK God for doing big things to help you trust Him.

READ PSALM 33:4-6

NAY 2

300,000,000,000,000,000,000,000. Do you even know how to say that number or do you just know it's big? That's how many stars scientists estimate are in the universe. Our sun is just ONE of those stars. And even though it looks big and far away to us, it's nowhere near being the biggest of the stars. Can you believe God created all those stars? All of them, every last one of them, by simply speaking. A God who can do something that big, that amazing—that's a God we can trust.

Create or find some of your own stars to add to your map, near the word FAITH to remind you that the same God who made all the stars, wants you to trust Him. Your stars can be stickers or hand drawn with markers or glitter pens. You could even cut or fold shiny foil and glue your custom stars down.

ASK God to remind you of all the big things He's done every time you see the sun or stars.



READ JEREMIAH 10:12

DAY 3

God has so much power and He used it to make the earth. He has so much wisdom and He used it to set the world in its place. He has so much knowledge and He used it to spread out the skies. It's pretty easy to trust a God who can do all that.

Ask a parent for a coffee filter or napkin, a squirt bottle, and some blue and green washable markers. Use the markers to scribble on the filter or napkin to make it look like a globe (blue for the water, green for the land). Then squirt just a bit of water onto the filter or napkin (just one or two squirts!) and watch the colors go! Let it completely dry and then tape it to the empty corner on your map. Every time you see it, you'll remember that the same God who made the earth, made you too!

LOOK around at everything God has made and thank Him for it!

READ MATTHEW 19:26

DAY 4

Did you know you can't sneeze with your eyes open? You also can't tickle yourself. Try it!

Now create a short list of things that seem SO big or impossible that you won't be able to do them without God's help:

Take this list and write a few key words or phrases on your map, near the word FAITH, to remind you that you can trust God even with the impossible. Then pray and ask God to help you with these "impossible" things, knowing that with Him, nothing is impossible!

KNOW that God can make the impossible possible!
